

Three friends quilt pattern

Quilt size 82" x 98", finished block is 16", in the quilt
 Blocks: ± 4 yards of various light fabrics, and
 ± 4 yards of various dark fabrics (Jelly roll will work well)
 Binding: 1 yard for the binding cut in to 3" strips
 Batting and backing: 94" x 110" of batting and backing fabric.
 You are going to make 30 blocks, finished size 16½" (15 with a dark and 15 with a light centre)

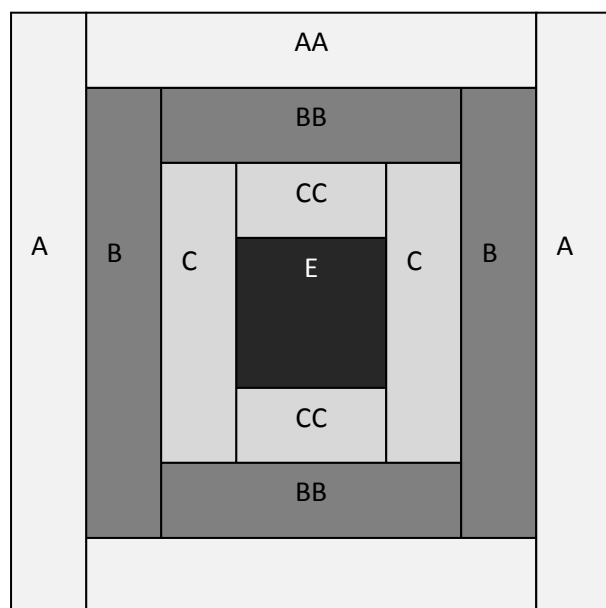

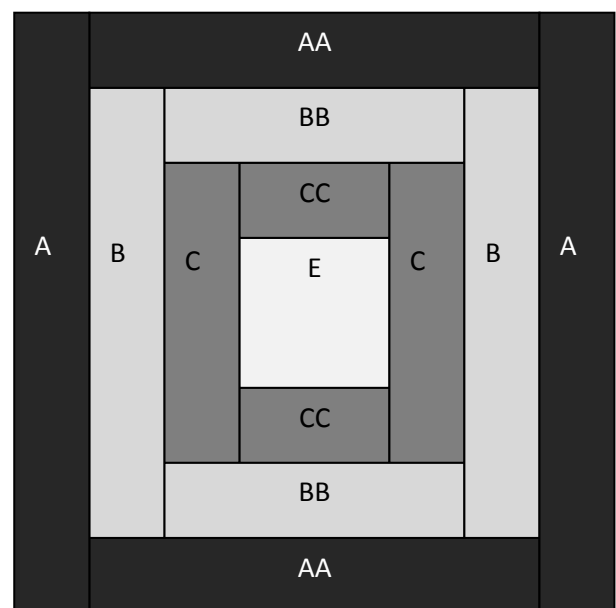
Cutting

Remember to cut 15 from your dark fabrics and 15 from light fabrics for the centre block (E) before you cut your 2½" strips.
 Cut strips of 2½" x 44" you will need 2 strips of one colour to cut and complete the last round (A and AA), the other you just need 1 strip.

Dark Centre block (15 blocks)



Light Centre block (15 blocks)



Cut 2 patches as follows for the **dark** centre block except E is 1 patch

A	AA	B	BB	C	CC	E
2½" x 16½"	2½" x 12½"	2½" x 12½"	2½" x 8½"	2½" x 8½"	2½" x 4½"	4½" square

Cut 2 patches as follows for the **light** centre block except E is 1 patch

A	AA	B	BB	C	CC	E
2½" x 16½"	2½" x 12½"	2½" x 12½"	2½" x 8½"	2½" x 8½"	2½" x 4½"	4½" square

Sew blocks according to two diagrams above, 15 with dark centres and 15 with light centres. Press after every stage. Now sew one dark centre block to a light centre block then make-up rows 6 x 5.

Join rows to complete quilt. Baste quilt - top, batting, backing together and quilt as desired.

Bind quilt and label.
